# The San Diego 4 Course Challenge

# **Presented by**

### **Outside the Circle Disc Golf Club**

Beginning Monday, November 3rd, and running through Sunday, November 30th, Outside the Circle challenges you to test your all-around game across four courses throughout San Diego County.

Each week features a different course. You can play that course up to three times, and your best round will count toward your total score.

There will be eight divisions with cash payouts going to the Top 3 finishers in each division. The more players in your division, the higher the payouts.

#### Here are some details on the event:

So, what four courses are we playing?

- Week 1 Kit Carson Park
  - o Monday, November 3 Sunday, November 9th
- Week 2 Mast Park
  - o Monday, November 10th Sunday, November 16th
- Week 3 Brengle Terrace
  - Monday, November 17th Sunday, November 23rd
- Week 4 Morley Field
  - o Monday, November 24th Sunday, November 30th

If there are payouts to the winners, does this mean there is an entry fee?

- There is a one-time entry fee based on your division-this entry fee covers your 4 weeks:
  - MPO, FPO, MA1 = \$40 per person
  - MA2 and FA1 = \$30 per person
  - MA3 and FA2 = \$25 per person
  - MA4 = \$20 per person

### How do the divisions work?

You choose your division, and please choose accurately. If we notice someone signed up for a division they do not belong to, we will ask you to correctly adjust your division. We have 5 mixed divisions and 3 Female divisions; use that as a guide comparison to where you normally fall in tag matches, example, if you finish in the top 20%, go to the top division, if you finish in the bottom 20% sign up in the bottom division, and so on.

Let's get back to the payouts; how is that broken up?

- Each division will have the same breakdown
  - 1st Place receives 40%
  - 2nd Place receives 25%
  - 3rd Place receives 15%
  - 20% goes to Outside the Circle

Why is 20% going back to Outside the Circle? What will that money be used for?

We're just two regular dudes running this thing, and our pockets aren't deep. That 20% helps fund future club events, food and drinks for tag matches, club merch, and awards for the 2026 Tag Season — all ways we give back to the community.

Ok, back to the event rounds, so I can play each course up to three times?

Players can complete each course up to three times during its assigned week, but only
one round will count toward the event. Your best round from that week will be used in
your total score. All rounds must be played with at least one other Challenge participant
from any division, and all scores must be entered through the UDisc Event for that week
on the same day the round is played. If you experience any issues with UDisc, reach out
so we can assist.

What if I don't know that many people?

 If you need a card, we'll host a group meetup each weekend to make sure everyone has a chance to play with other participants. We also highly recommend using the group
 Facebook page to post that you are looking for a group.

# What determines the placements?

 Your final event score will be the combined sum of your best round from each of the four courses. If you miss a course, that week will count as par plus ten strokes above the lowest score from your division. All scores must be verified by at least one other player on your card. In the event of a scoring dispute, Outside the Circle will review the round and make a final ruling.

Will we be able to see standings after each week?

• Yes, there will be weekly recaps through the Outside the Circle Facebook and Instagram pages, so make sure you are following both.

How do I submit my scorecard?

• There will be a UDisc Event each week; it is essential to use UDisc Events when playing each week. If you have any trouble, please let us know.

How are ties going to be settled?

 In the event of a tie for any podium position, tied players must play a head-to-head round within one week of the event's conclusion. Players may agree on the course and time; however, if they cannot reach an agreement, Outside the Circle will assign both. If a player cannot complete the tiebreaker within that week, the other player will take the higher placement by default.

Ok, so when I win, how do I get paid?

• Winners will receive their payouts via Venmo or PayPal within 48 hours of final results being posted.

This sounds awesome; how do I sign up?

- If a course is closed or unplayable during its assigned week, Outside the Circle may extend the play window or substitute a nearby course at its discretion.
- Entry fees are non-refundable once the event begins, and if you sign up but are unable to participate, your fee will still go toward payouts and club funding.
