General Rules

Follow the rules listed below. Repeat the same rules on the second loop.

4 - Safety Fence Line MANDO -> If disc CROSSES FENCE LINE AT ANY POINT. Play your previous lie as your next shot (Do not proceed to next lie or where disc crossed, Do not take OB Stroke Penalty)

5 - Walking Path and Beyond OB

6 - Walking Path and Beyond OB

7 - Walking Path and Beyond OB

8 - Walking Path and Beyond OB

9 - Train Tracks and Beyond OB

Concrete Tees

General Rules

1. All ball golf putting greens are OB (shortest grass only, not the “fringe” of the green).
2. All sand bunkers are played as hazards: play the disc as it lies with one penalty throw.
3. All ponds and bodies of water are OB unless otherwise specified below.
4. Perceived Foxwood property lines, as delineated by fencing (ie. Hole 12 White), stakes or other markings, represent OB.
5. Gravel, dirt, and asphalt paths are not OB unless otherwise specified below. There are a few new cart paths (like hole 8, 18) that stick out into fairways, these are not OB.
6. Grass is not OB unless specifically noted on a hole-by-hole basis below. Where “long grass” is designated as OB, “long grass” is any significant section of grass that is longer than the standard “rough” of the ball-golf course, regardless of whether there are multiple cut levels of such long grass. Wherever a lie is difficult to distinguish as OB due to ambiguous grass cut line, the group is to make best efforts to agree on a ruling, with any impasse to be resolved in favour of in bounds.
7. There are mandatory flight paths on select holes. For all double mandatories, in the absence of a painted/flagged line, the mandatory line extends from the two points in a straight line indefinitely. If the disc crosses backward across the mando line it has also missed the mando, as per PDGA rules.
8. Where an OB border (e.g., an asphalt path that has been designated OB) ends arbitrarily, the OB is deemed to continue infinitely on a straight line in the last direction of the defined border.

Foxwood OB and mandos

Hole 1 – The tree line/grass line along the forest left side is OB, long grass left side beyond forest is OB.

Long grass to the left of the tee pad, and between tee pad and forest, including any maintenance path, is not OB. Long grass right side is not OB.

Hole 2 – Golf green is the only OB.

Hole 3 – Long grass right side of the fairway is OB. Creek beyond basket is not OB, if water is present, casual relief is permitted.

Hole 4 – Cart path and beyond is OB. Creek is not OB. If water is present, casual relief is permitted.

Hole 5 – Cart path left and beyond is OB. Long grass on right side of fairway is not OB. All OB tee shots proceed to drop zone with one penalty throw. Thereafter, standard OB rules apply. Creek in front of basket is not OB. If water is present, casual relief is permitted.

Hole 6 – There is no OB for grass or forest, only the usual rules for the golf green and sand traps apply.

Hole 7 – Double mandatory: disc must pass between the two marked trees. Drop zone marked between the trees.

Hole 8 – Cart path right side, and beyond, is OB.

Hole 9 – Long grass, and forest beyond, right side of fairway is OB. The cut maintenance route near the basket and the long grass bordering the pond are not OB.

Hole 10 – Only the long grass directly behind the basket, up to the maintenance path, is OB.

Maintenance path and beyond is not OB. Creek is not OB, if water is present, casual relief is permitted.

Hole 13 – Long grass, and beyond - including any cut maintenance routes, along right side is all OB.

Hole 14 – Grass around the pond is not OB. Path and right is OB.

Hole 15 – There is no OB for grass or forest, only the usual rules for the golf green and sand traps apply.

Hole 17 – Double mandatory: disc must pass between the marked trees. Drop zone is indicated on the right-hand side mando tree.

Hole 18 – All paved areas, and beyond, are OB.
