COURSE RULES / DISC GOLF ETIQUETTE



Clean up after yourself! Please use garbage / recycling bins provided or Pack in pack out!



Don't be a distraction. When others are throwing, get out of their line of sight, don't move and be quiet.



Lowest score from the previous hole throws first on the next hole. As you play, the person farthest away from the basket throws first.



If your disc goes onto an adjoining fairway, right of way goes to the players on the higher numbered hole.



Help your card mates! Watch your card mates throws and help look for lost discs. If more than 3 minutes, consider it a lost disc.

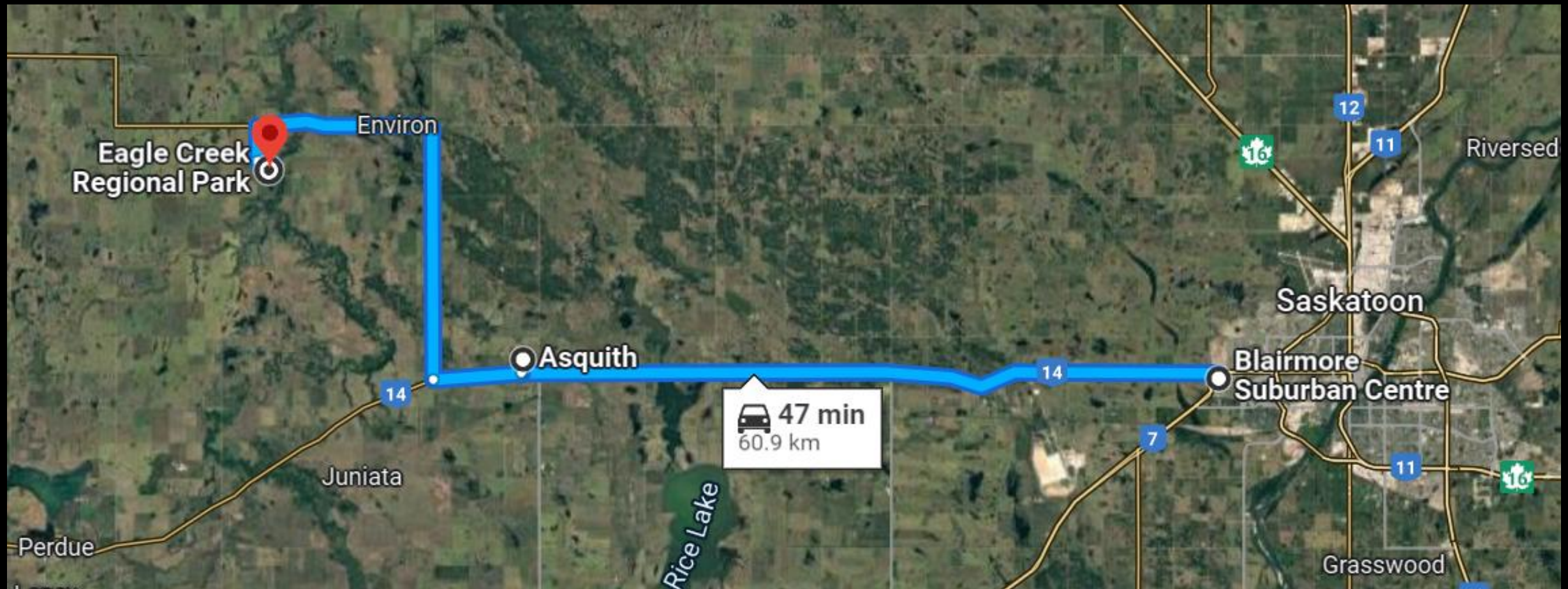

- For the official PDGA Rules, please follow this link: <https://www.pdga.com/rules/official-rules-disc-golf>
- Some important rules are highlighted below:
- There are some holes on the course that will cause you to throw a Mandatory Route. If you miss the Mando, you will be required to throw your next shot from the indicated Drop Zone and add 1 penalty stroke to your score.
- There are Out of Bounds areas throughout the course. If you throw a disc OB, you will be required to throw your next shot perpendicular to the line on which your previous disc went OB and add 1 penalty stroke to your score OR from a Drop Zone (only if indicated) and add 1 penalty stroke to your score. You may take a 1-meter relief from any Out of Bounds line or barbed wire fence.
- A disc is declared lost if the player cannot locate it within three minutes after having arrived at the area where it is thought to be. Any player in the group or an Official may begin the timing of the three minutes and must inform the group that the timing has begun. A player whose disc has been declared lost receives one penalty throw. The next throw is made from the previous lie. If a drop zone has been designated for lost discs on the hole, the player may throw from the drop zone instead of from the previous lie. All players on the card are required to help find the lost disc. The Three-minute timer starts when all players are present to search for the disc. ** We need this rule in place to keep the tournament schedule on time!! Please help out by obliging us! If a tournament director sees a card not following this rule, all players on that card will be assessed a penalty stroke.

SCOREKEEPING

- We will be using UDisc for live scoring of this event – through the event function. Once we make the event public, you will be able to see your tee times for your 1st round. You will need to check in on Saturday morning and designate a score keeper from your card. Etiquette dictates that it is the 1st person listed on the card unless that person has kept score in a previous round (no dead battery excuses!)
- We will ask that when you are done your round and **all of your players have confirmed their score**, come down to tournament central and log into our starlink Wi-Fi: AHDG Invitational. Wi-fi password will be at tournament central.
- We will update all player scores and new tee times into UDisc before each round. Please note: we will not have a paper player score board this year. All results and tee time info will be found in UDisc.

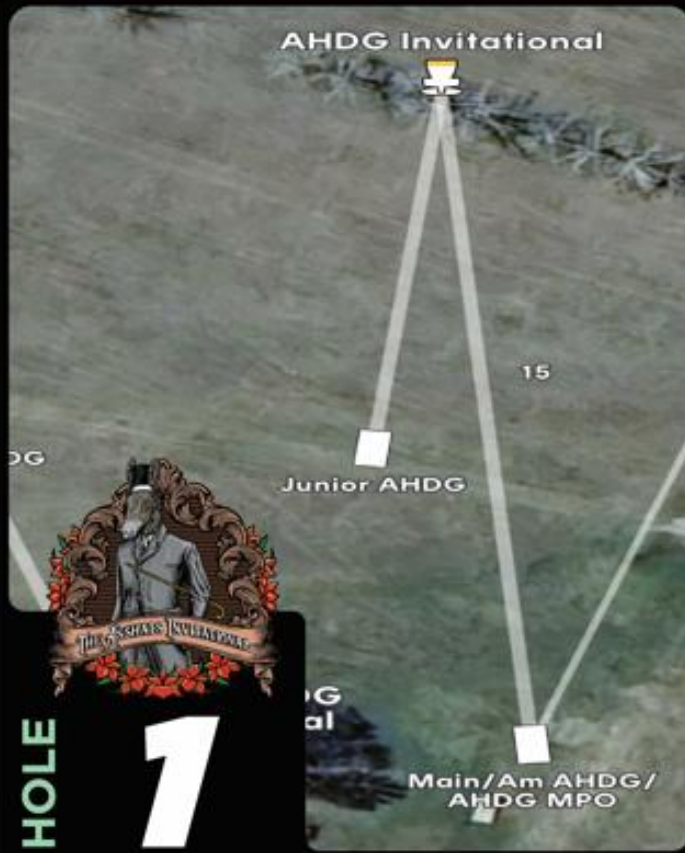

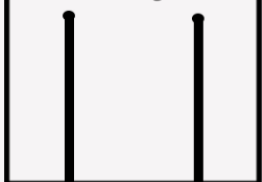
FRICKET

BASIC RULES

Fricket has 2 wickets, throw the frisbee to hit the wicket or score between the wickets

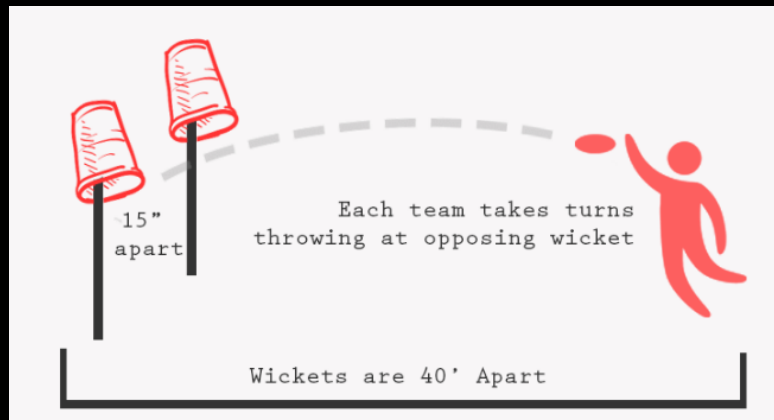
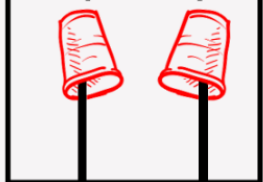
WICKET

2 Poles 15" apart
"like a goal"



CUPS

Place a Solo Cup
on top of the pole



HOW TO SCORE

1. Hit 1 or both wickets to knock off the cups. Each cup that hits ground = 1 point
2. Defense tries to catch the knocked off cups one-handed. If they do = 1 point for defense
3. If Frisbee thrown between wickets without touching either wicket = 2 points

HOW TO WIN

Be the first team to score 21 points
Switch sides of field at 16 points.

GLOW ROUND

- We are going to use a made up 9-hole course around the main area of the golf course. We will have solar lights out on the course to mark the tees!
- Glow round will happen from 9:30 to 11:30pm on Saturday May 23rd.
- This is a totally optional, fun round for those that want to participate!



STUFF AND THINGS

In your player packs, there are 2 different colors of tickets. All adult players get a Flatlander Cider from Crossmount. Please take your white ticket to the merch concession to claim your cold cider (graciously donated by Crossmount!) Juniors will use their white ticket for a Gatorade or Pop.

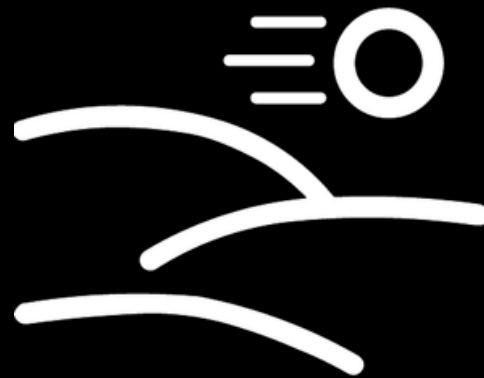
