## Getting to Þorláksgeisli 51 (Geisli clubhouse – Grafarholtsvöllur)

### By Public Transit – Strætó (Yellow Buses)



- Website: [straeto.is](https://straeto.is)
- App: *Klappið* – For real-time bus info, route planning, and payment
- Payment: Use the app or pay onboard with your **debit card**
- Relevant Bus Routes:
  - Route 104 – Goes into the Grafarholt neighborhood
  - Route 18 – Another option that reaches nearby


 Use the route planner on the **Strætó app or website** and enter your starting point and **Þorláksgeisli 51** as the destination.

### 💧 Water Tip:

Icelandic **tap water is perfectly safe** – hot water may smell due to natural sulfur, but it's clean.

## Driving & Car Rental

- **Traffic Cameras Are Everywhere**  
Speeding tickets can be **very expensive**—so drive carefully, especially in and around Reykjavík, tunnels, and rural highways.
  - **Headlights ON – Always!**
    - ✓ Required 24/7, regardless of weather or daylight.
    - ✗ **Do NOT use the “Auto” setting**—it often doesn't activate tail lights, which is a ticketable offense.
  - **Weather Can Change Quickly**  
Always check road.is or vedur.is for real-time weather and road conditions—especially in winter or if you plan to leave the capital area.

## Shopping

- **Main Malls:**
    - **Kringlan** – Centrally located, many Icelandic brands, restaurants, and a cinema.
    - **Smáralind** – Largest shopping mall in Iceland, located in Kópavogur. Includes shops like Zara, H&M, and a food court.
  - **Groceries:**
    - Shop at **Bónus** or **Krónan** for affordable groceries and snacks.
    - Icelandic supermarkets do **not** sell strong alcohol—only low-alcohol beer. Visit the **state-run Vínbúðin** for wine and spirits.

## Currency & Payment

- **Currency:** Icelandic Króna (ISK)
  - Credit/debit cards are **accepted everywhere**, including taxis, gas stations, and vending machines.
